## RULES FOR PICK-UP & DELIVERY OF ALCOHOL DURING THE COVID -19 OUTBREAK

1. You may only deliver beverages you are licensed to sell on-premise.
2. You may only offer take-out and delivery during hours you are licensed to sell on-premise.
3. All wine & spirits must be in sealed containers such as growlers (mixed drinks may be sold).
4. Food must also be picked-up or delivered with the orders.
5. Alcohol may be delivered:
  - in vehicles owned and operated by the licensee with a copy of the liquor license in the vehicle;
  - in a vehicle not owned by the licensee that has a Transportation Permit from the New York State Liquor Authority and is operated by the employee who obtained the permit (this could be an employee of the licensee using his personal vehicle);
  - by a third-party delivery company that has obtained a Transportation Permit from the New York State Liquor Authority (it is best practice to ask drivers to produce a copy of the permit for inspection).
