PROGRAM GOALS

- Establish a national standard and assessment for job-readiness skills.
- Highlight the hospitality industry as a opportunity-rich place for first jobs, and as a model of employment, development and advancement.
- Foster collaboration between community organizations, state restaurant associations, industry partners, and employers.
- Provide additional resources and opportunity for people who are out of school, unemployed, or underemployed.

Hospitality Opportunities for People (Re)Entering Society (HOPES)





HOPES sets justice-involved individuals on a path to employment and independence through training and employment opportunities in the restaurant and hospitality industry, including connections to apprenticeship.

The HOPES program utilizes the NRAEF's Restaurant Ready training curriculum to equip individuals with work-readiness and industry-specific training. As of 2024, the HOPES program had over 1,200 participants.

WHY IT WORKS

- Restaurant careers are accessible, diverse, and opportunity rich.
- Restaurants need a well-trained and qualified workforce.
- HOPES participants receive ServSafe training which is widely recognized and teaches health and hygiene guidelines.

76% of Restaurant Ready/HOPES participants land industry jobs.





Restaurants employ more minority managers than any other industry and **90%** of all restaurant managers started in entry-level positions.
